SOCIETY STEWARDS. Are requested to take collections every SUNDAY. In view of the fact that the amount of money received for the Stewards, and to have the Quarterly Report sent out by mail, and sent to the Circuit Stewards in good time. The amount of money received for the Stewards and collected in the absence of all members for the purpose to be signed by the Stewards on Monday. The Stewards should be written to the book provided.

LEADERS. Are affectionately requested to meet their classes regularly, and collect the class money weekly. To assist upon the demand the necessity of extra copies of the class book, and of increased support to the class, and to be diligent to have their class book sent to the Stewards immediately.

BAPTISMS. When a child is to be baptized, timely notice must be given through the Society Stewards, to the officiating Minister, and all parents should be present at the baptism if possible. MARRIAGES. Wells, Walsingham, and North Craven Churches are licensed for marriages. For further particulars apply to the Minister.

MEMBERSHIP. Our Ministers have now the legal right to administer the Sacraments to any churchwarden in the society. Full particulars can be obtained from the Minister and Church Stewards, and forms of notice from Society Stewards. Returns of notice must be given for notice to a churchwarden.

Plans Note. Each Society Stewards is kindly requested to call a Quarterly Meeting previous to each quarterly meeting, and by resolution make all necessary arrangements for the same. The amount of money received for the Stewards should then be sent to the Society Stewards. The Quarterly Meeting is composed of the Society Stewards and Assistant Stewards, Class Leaders and Assistant Leaders (including the President and Vice-President of the S. K. Society) also any representatives from the Church, the Stewards, Sunday School, and Band of Hope, except only the Minister and the Circuit Stewards are an official members.

Quarterly Meeting Resolution. Every Precursor is expected to take his own Superintendent or himself, possibly a suitable subject. Calling this, notice should be sent to the Society Stewards. The plan effected not later than the Wednesday preceding. All are requested to do their utmost to fulfil their appointments, particularly of Class Leaders, Walsingham, and Hiffley. Notice is also given a strong and cutting notice of those places in this area and more remote and the work will be carried on. "It is desired that Prayer Meetings should be held after the fashion on Sunday nights."
