

Circuit Regulations.

1. **Local Preachers.** All preachers who accept the Plan thereby engage to fulfil their own appointments, or themselves undertake to provide an accredited substitute.

2. **Requests.** Local Preachers, Society Stewards, and other officials kindly note all requests and notices affecting the next Plan must be made in writing to the Superintendent on or before the Quarterly Meeting.

3. **Society Stewards** are requested: (a) To furnish the Preachers (for announcement) with written notices of all Sunday and week-night services; (b) To have all collections duly published and made, and forward all collections for Connexional Funds to the respective Treasurers without delay; (c) To receive from the Leaders the Class contributions, and forward them with the Circuit Fund collections and the Society Quarterly Report to the Circuit Steward the Monday before the Quarterly Meeting; (d) To provide homes for the Preachers when necessary.

4. **Chapel Stewards.** (a) Make provision for the Lord's Supper, and receive the collections made and dispense them as directed by the Leaders' Meeting; (b) Make provision for Baptism; (c) Furnish the Minister with names and addresses of sick members and adherents.

5. **Class Leaders** are specially charged with the spiritual oversight of their respective Classes, and should encourage the members to contribute weekly as a Christian duty and privilege to the support of the work of God. They distribute Quarterly Class Tickets and collect the Class Money, and enter the same in a Class Book, and hand the amount to the Society Steward the week before the Quarterly Meeting.

6. **Chapel Stewards** attend to the lettings of sittings, and see that the Chapel and Vestries, etc., are properly cleaned, warmed, and ventilated, and look after the general comfort of the worshippers.

Marriages are solemnised at the following Chapels: Aylsham, Corpusty, Colby, Sustead, Itteringham, Briston, Hindolveston, Bawdeswell, Reephams, Sparham, Bintree, Foulsham and Cawston. Full particulars from the Ministers.

Baptisms. Due notice should be given to the Society Stewards. Both parents should be present if possible. A stamped certificate of registration, price 6d., can be obtained if desired.

Burials. Our Ministers have authority to conduct funerals in any churchyard. Forty-eight hours notice must be given to the Incumbent. For particulars apply to the Ministers.
